Classes: Classes expected to compete include <u>PHRF A, B, C, NS</u> (double headsails allowed), One-Design classes, plus a special Cruising class. Fleets may be further subdivided. One Design classes, monohull over 20 feet LOA, with at least five registered boats are encouraged and will be offered a separate start. OD Classes must make (5 entries complete) no later than May 20th. Cruising Class boats (non-sanctioned, single headsail only) will receive a courtesy rating which may not be appealed. The Cruising Fleet races Saturday and Sunday only. PHRF boats must have a current valid PHRF rating

certificate. PHRF and Cruising fleet boats must meet current category 4P of the PHRF Special Regulations for safety and accommodations.

Races: NEW! Racing on a different venue in a different format each day for PHRF Spinnaker Classes A, B, C, PHRF Non-Spin (double headsails allowed), One-Design classes, and Cruising;

- On <u>Friday</u>, May 31, PHRF and One Design classes multiple races (triangle/windward/leeward) in Hampton Roads harbor;
- On <u>Saturday</u>, June 1, PHRF, One Design, and Cruising classes distance race in the Bay off Buckroe/Salt Ponds; also, scored in the 2013 Southern Bay Distance Racing Series
- On <u>Sunday</u>, June 2, PHRF and One Design classes multiple races (windward/leeward) off Ocean View, and the Cruising fleet will do one mixed legs race.

Racing begins at 10:00am each day. The Low Point Scoring System will be used.
