Cape Henry Cup Report, May 18th, 2013:

When I woke up on the morning of the 18th, I thought, "man, this is not going to be fun", as it poured down rain... and I kept thinking it as my Dad, Hank, and I drove to Hampton Yacht Club to board SALTY DOG for the upcoming miserable ride out to Buckroe Beach for the start. Turns out I couldn't have been more wrong! As we set up the starting line, the rain tapered off and shortly thereafter, 22 boats headed ENE in about 15 knots of breeze on the 20.3 mile course around government navigational aids in the Southern Bay. The rain held off (at least over the race committee's heads) and after a quick lunch, we spent a short time on the beach at Ft. Monroe finishing the fleet. The first boat to finish, SEA STAR (PHRF A and Cape Henry Cup winner), finished just before 1pm and the last boat finished just after 2:30pm. Big thanks to John McCarthy for the use of his boat and his eyeballs at the starting line. Thanks also to Mac Collins, Mike McGraw (Megan's Dad), and Hank Almond for helping me on the race committee. Eleven BBSA members competed in the event, which is the 2nd race in the Southern Bay Distance Racing Series (SBDRS). Here are our top finishers:

Classes – PHRF: A, B, C, and separate Nonspin classes for single and double headsails. (Current PHRF valid rating required) Several Cruising Classes and a Multihull Class with committee-assigned handicaps.

Anyone Can Win – PHRF Nonspinnaker participants will receive an 18 sec/mi handicap bonus for Cape Charles Cup PHRF Division Trophy calculations.

Time - First Flag: 1000 hours both days.

Prizes - Daily class awards based on number of entries. Cape Charles Cups for the best total corrected time in PHRF, Cruising and Multihull divisions (13boat minimum). Keeper trophies are traditional big brass Weems and Plath yacht lamps, plus winning boats’ names on the perpetual trophy.

Berthing – Call Kings Creek Marina for slip reservations at (757) 331-8640. You must be entered to obtain a slip – please allow 3 business days after entering before you call for reservations. Let them know when you make your reservation if you prefer to be in the Party or Family section. Docking at Cape Charles Harbor continues to be an option for those who may be concerned about channel depth; (757) 331-2357.
