PHRF Racing News:

The prep flag is dropping on the 2015 racing season, so if you haven't signed up for either of our week night 'beer can' racing series, which start this month, please go to our website for registration and details (and race scoring). Randy Goodman and Guy Sorensen are the lead dogs for these series (LCSA and WR, respectively) for BBSA. Payment of racing dues can be done online as well: www.broadbaysailing.org/renew/index.asp.

The Notices of Race for all of our PHRF/big-boat weekend races have been posted in the PHRF Notices of Race area of the Downloads section of our

website, <u>www.broadbaysailing.org/downloads/index.asp</u>. Also, you can find the 2015 Southern Bay racing schedule posted on the lower right hand corner of our homepage, <u>www.broadbaysailing.og</u>.

It's not too early to register for the most competitive racing event in the area, Southern Bay Race Week. Their lineup is solid: 3 days of racing and 4 parties! Racing in the Cruising Fleet features 2 days of racing for a reduced entry fee. You're not going to want to miss this (or the early bird discount that comes with 10 free beverage tix... link to info is below). What are you waiting for?

Don't forget to renew or apply for your PHRF Valid Rating as well as Chesapeake Bay Yacht Racing Association (CBYRA) membership:

-CBYRA - for eligibility in their season long High Point competition; the Southern Bay has its own division (Region IV) for trophies. If you haven't done this before, give it a shot this year. There's no extra work as you're probably already racing in many of the area's CBRYA-sanctioned events (like BBSA's Cape Henry Cup, Cape Charles Cup, and Neptune's Atlantic

-PHRF of the Chesapeake (for your Valid Rating) http://www.phrfchesbay.org/bin/renew.php. Two-step process; fill out the electronic application/renewal form and then use the link below it to pay online. Both new applications AND renewals must use BOTH steps (you can't just pay for a renewal without submitting the renewal form). Put BBSA in the blank for Primary Club and put your (newly acquired?) CBYRA membership number in the blank for CBYRA.

The Cape Henry Cup Race will be sailed on Saturday, May 16th. This is the first of four CBYRA-sanctioned races sponsored by BBSA this year and Race #2 in the Southern Bay Distance Racing Series (SBDRS).
