



ELIGIBILITY: All PHRF boats must have a current, valid PHRF of the Chesapeake rating certificate. PHRF CR ratings will be used. Cruising Fleet boats will be assigned a courtesy rating by the RC. ORC Cruisers must have a current, valid ORC Club Certificate.

SAFETY REQUIRMENTS: All boats must meet US Sailing Nearshore Safety Equipment Requirements. These requirements are posted on the HYC website. In addition, all boats are required to also meet the following US Sailing Coastal Safety Equipment Requirements. For a complete explanation of each item, go to the US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements shown on the HYC website. Also note, as per US Sailing Requirement 1.2 - The safety of a boat and her crew is the sole and inescapable responsibility of the "person in charge", as per RRS 46....

- ** The additional requirements boats are required to follow are:
- 2.5.1 A permanently installed manual bilge pump...
- 2.7.2 A mechanical propulsion system capable of driving the boat at a minimum speed...for 4 hours.
- 3.1.1 Each crew member shall have a life jacket that provides at least 33.7 lbs (150N) of buoyancy, intended to be worn over the shoulders (no belt pack) meeting either US Coast Guard or ISO specifications.
- 3.1.4 Each crew member shall have a safety harness....
- 3.7.1 A Lifesling or equivalent man overboard rescue device equipped with a self-igniting light....
- 3.14 A GPS receiver
- 3.15 An electronic means to record the position of a man overboard.... This may be the same as in 3.14.
- 3.24.1 A watertight, high-powered searchlight....
- 3.26 A radar reflector.
- 3.32 A strong, sharp knife

STARTING LINE: Between a staff displaying an orange flag on the RC Boat and CCV Harbor Mark "H" (R N "20").

FINISH LINE: Between CCV Mark "Q" (Bay) (Q R R'22') and an orange flag on the Ft Monroe seawall. Boats finishing after dark shall hail the race committee via VHF-72 and shine a bright light on their sail number. Boats finishing when the race committee is not present shall record their finish time as specified in the Prescription to Rule 34 and report that time to the race committee at the contact number (C) 757-951-7961. Boats failing to do this may not be scored.




BBSA Name Tags, Mary Anne Greblunas:

BBSA Membership Spotlight John and Lin McCarthy

Tenure at BBSA:

When we began sailing and purchased our first boat (Hunter 28.5, deep keel), we took a good friend's advice and joined BBSA. That was in 1986. BBSA was meeting in the Sunday School meeting hall at a church in the London Bridge area. We had recently moved back to Virginia from Rocky Mount, NC, and lived in Ocean Park. We loved the casual, informal atmosphere of the BBSA meetings and the good-natured boisterousness of the racers in particular.

We began racing at the BBSA Willoughby Racers Thursday Nights and John eventually became responsible for running the series. Lin wrote the monthly *Willoughby Racers* newsletter, a labor of love for sure.

We are still very close to BBSA friends first made at Willoughby in those years. Willoughby Racers and BBSA gave us the opportunity to grow as racers and led John eventually to become a US Sailing Regional Race Officer (well over 20 years at that level) and a US Sailing National Judge (10 years). We put together and John developed and taught our first "Performance Racing" classes at Willoughby. The Willoughby Racers spent several winter Thursday nights jammed into the marina lounge, sat on the floor, ate lasagna, drank beer, and discussed just how important it was to get excess weight off the race boat – "hell yeah, cut the handle off your toothbrush!". And there were the first Hot Buttered Rum Race parties, forerunners of today's BBSA unique socials.

John was BBSA Race Captain for a number of years and served as PRO for countless BBSA races, including 10 consecutive years as PRO for the Leo Wardrup Memorial Cape Charles Cup regatta.

During those early years we raced at least 100 races each summer. *Ulysses* (the Hunter 28.5) did every weekly HYC Wednesday and every Willoughby Thursday, occasional Portsmouth Boat Club Friday Barnacle Races, and of course multiple races most weekends – essentially every real race between here and Fishing Bay. It always seemed that we all wanted to race and considering not to go just never came up. Not surprisingly, *Sugar Bear* continued in the same pattern.

We grew with our loyal crew and we all learned a lot together and stayed together through most of our racing career. We moved up in boats and fleets and won championships, including the coveted Southern Bay Race Week Boat of the Week, CCV fleets and even a CBYRA Bay-wide Class C title. We went Non-Spin to PHRF C, to PHRF A, where we experienced 8 years of the joy of our sailing lives with *SUGAR BEAR*, a J33 we purchased from Dave Zanks in Poquoson.

Our roots for all our sailing endeavors began and were nurtured in BBSA, and to this day, the organization and the members have a special place in our hearts.

We have moved to Hampton and Hampton Yacht Club, a natural progression of things, but still maintain our membership at BBSA.

When John gave up the tiller and I came off the foredeck of *Sugar Bear*, it was because of physical issues that made regular racing impossible. We gravitated to a 28 foot Maine Lobster Boat (*Salty Dog*), which became an ideal Race Management signal boat for us for the next 13 years.

Southern Bay Racing News You Can Use was born twenty-three (23) years ago, while Lin served 3 consecutive terms as CBYRA Region 4 (aka Southern Bay) Vice-President, and the electronic weekly became the glue helping keep all of our Southern Bay sailing organizations together and up to date on our happenings.
