BBSA Skippers, Crew, and Friends,

I hope you all had a wonderful Thanksgiving and I wish you the best as we enter the December holiday season.

I'm excited to announce that we will celebrate the **65th Anniversary of the Broad Bay Sailing Association**, founded in 1958, at the **2024 BBSA Winter Banquet and Inauguration Dinner on January 27th at Norfolk Yacht and Country Club (NYCC)**. NYCC is a wonderful venue, and we will have seating for 60 people. We are opening this dinner to BBSA members and crew. We recommend purchasing your tickets as soon as possible.

2023 Year in Review:

We have a great deal to be proud of within BBSA in 2023. Our club has been actively planning and coordinating sailing and social events afloat and ashore for the membership all year long. We are very active in all four seasons including racing, cruising, training, and social events.

- <u>Racing</u>: BBSA is widely recognized as having the most active sailboat racing program in the Southern Chesapeake Bay. Between Little Creek, Willoughby and the Hobie Fleet, BBSA has close to 60 boats that regularly race during the week. We offered over 70 days of racing in 2023.
- **Website**: **Eric Brinsfield** has done an exceptional job with the BBSA website, making it easy for members to find information about events, races, and cruises. Eric recently expanded the offerings on the BBSA Homepage, making finding events even easier.
- <u>Training</u>: BBSA Training Officer, Larry Baun, organized a great Winter Training Program in 2023, including multiple RRS and Rules of the Road Trivia Nights, a John McCarthy Racing Rules Seminar, an Evolution Sails led Sail Trim presentation at Sail Nauticus, and an "Everything You Want to Know about PHRF" seminar.
- **<u>Race Management</u>**: BBSA had 6 US Sailing Certified Race Officers within our membership in 2023.
- Honorary BBSA Members: BBSA was proud to select long-time BBSA Members, John and Lin McCarthy as Honorary BBSA Members in 2023.
- <u>Bold Mariner Cup</u>: With a Willoughby win in 2022, Little Creek won back the Cup in 2023.
- **<u>Cruising</u>**: The BBSA Cruisers are quite active and scheduled **close to 20 cruises** in 2023.
- <u>Leo Wardrup Memorial Cape Charles Cup</u>: The 2023 Leo Wardrup Memorial Cape Charles Cup was a tremendous success, as we celebrated the **20th Anniversary** of the race. For the 7th year in a row, the Cape Charles Cup was voted the Best Sailing Regatta in the Chesapeake Bay during Chesapeake Bay Magazine's "Best of the Bay" Survey.
- Finances: After 10 years as the BBSA Treasurer, Sergio Diehl passed the torch to Rob
 Williams. Despite the impacts of inflation, BBSA is in excellent "financial shape."

 Southern Bay Distance Racing Series (SBDRS): BBSA coordinates the scoring of the SBDRS for all the local clubs that have distance races in the series. Of the 15 boats that were on the podium, BBSA was well represented with 12 awards.

Tidewater Community College, Virginia Beach Campus, will be offering a Captains Course (Operator of Uninspected Passenger Vessels (OUPV) License Course, sometimes referred to as a Six Pack) starting on 16 January. The classes are from 1800 to 2130 on Tuesday and Thursday evenings. Course subjects include navigation rules and regulations, chart navigation, seamanship, lifesaving, and firefighting. Students who successfully complete this course do not have to take the U.S. Coast Guard examinations at a Regional Exam Center. Fees include tuition and books.
