Please pass by the transom of the RC boat and hail your sail number

Be acknowledged by RC

TIME LIMITS

Saturday at 1630 (or 1600 if race is shortened at the drop mark)

Sunday at 1630 (or 1600 if race is shortened at "X")

RC RADIO BROADCASTS (please keep channels clear)

VHF-72 (West Starting Area and Finish Line)

VHF-68 (East Starting Area; not used the rest of the day after the start)
