Big changes this year!

Because of COVID-19, we will not be staying over in Cape Charles. Instead, we have planned different and exciting courses for each day so racers can return to their homeports Saturday evening.

Entry Fee: \$75.00 if received by July 17th, \$95.00 if received thereafter and \$50.00 for first year participants. In accordance with the process described in your event registration confirmation, provide a photo of the boat and/or crew by July 17th to be included in the yearbook. Entry fees received by July 17th include registration, one Cape Charles Cup hat and tee shirt, a Cape Charles Cup skipper's bag loaded with useful and interesting stuff, and the final trophy presentation at a future BBSA meeting to be determined.

Entries and Deadline: Online entry at www.CCCup.net. Entries close at 1200 hours on August 10th.

A modified Skippers' "Meeting" @ 1830 hours on Friday, August 14th at 4317 Pretty Lake Avenue, Norfolk, at the corner of Shore Drive and Pretty Lake Avenue. The format for the meeting has yet to be determined but will comply with the **CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)** Guidelines of the Commonwealth of Virginia in force at the time of the event. Stay tuned.

Courses: Saturday: Start approximately 2 nm east of the Ocean View Fishing Pier and finish within 2 nm of the Pier. Sunday: Start approximately 1½ nm east of the Thimble Shoal Light and finish at Day Beacon R "2" / Buckroe (CCV Bay Mark "Y").

Divisions: PHRF A, B, C, N (2HS-double headsails allowed) and N (1HS-single headsail only) with current PHRF rating (www.phrfchesbay.org). PHRF Nonspinnaker classes will receive an 18 sec/mi handicap bonus for Cape Charles Cup Trophy calculations. Cruising (single headsail only), open to monohull boats that do not have a valid PHRF rating and/or skippers that race only occasionally (courtesy rating available from race organizers and shall not be subject to challenge). Handicap adjustments will be made for previous multiple race winners in the Cruising Division. CRCA with valid rating (<http://racercruiser.org/chesapeake-crca>) or courtesy rating assigned by race organizers. CMA/Multihull (no beach-launched vessels) with valid rating (courtesy ratings will be assigned by CMA: <http://www.chesapeakemultihulls.org/>). A division must have 4 entries by July 21st to be included.

Time: First Flag = 1000 hours Saturday and Sunday.

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. All monohulls must meet US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements for Near Shore (https://www.ussailing.org/wp-content/uploads/2020/01/US_SER_2019.0_Categories.pdf) as modified in the Sailing Instructions. All multihulls must meet US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements for Near Shore (<https://cdn.ussailing.org/wp-content/uploads/2020/01/Multihull-SER-Categories-2020.0.pdf>) as modified in the Sailing Instructions.

Results: Results will be posted at www.broadbaysailing.org.

Prizes: Daily class awards based on number of entries. Cape Charles Cup awards for the best total corrected time (Divisions with at least 13 entries). Winners will be notified of the time and place of the awards presentation. Please include phone number and e-mail address on entry form. All trophies will be awarded at a future BBSA meeting to be determined.
