ORC Cruiser (both fleets)	All ratings	Green (spin) and Purple (non-spin)
Cruising C	Over 188	Yellow (single headsail)**
Cruising B	149 - 187	Blue (single headsail)**
Cruising A	Under 148	White (single headsail)

\*\* the intent is to have a 5 minute pause in the sequence following these starts

### WARNING SIGNAL AND LOCATION

Saturday at 1000 approx. 4 miles NNE of Little Creek Inlet

Sunday at 1000 just West of Plantation Light

### BOAT CHECK-IN

All boats are requested to check-in with their respective RC boat each day

Please do not check in by radio.

Please pass by the transom of the RC boat and hail your sail number

Be acknowledged by RC

### TIME LIMITS

Saturday at 1630 (or 1600 if race is shortened at "1YR")

Sunday at 1630 (or 1600 if race is shortened at R "4")

### RC RADIO BROADCASTS (please keep channels clear)

VHF-72 (East Starting Area and Finish Line)

VHF-68 (West Starting Area; not used the rest of the day after the start)
