Revision 1

2) Registration and Fees

- c) All requirements to be scored must be met by 5:00 PM the day before the race.

IS CHANGED TO:

- c) All requirements to be scored must be met by 5:00 PM the Monday before the race.

This change is to align the SI with the NOR.

Revision 2

14) Scoring

- e) The RC boat's score for that race will be the boat's average score of non-excluded races for that series, rounded to the nearest tenth. (Example: 1-2-RC-4-5 shall be scored $(1+2)/2=1.5$ for the race when the boat performed RC duty.) Exception: If the race is abandoned, no boat will receive a score for that race.

IS CHANGED TO:

- e) The RC boat's score for that race will be the boat's average score of non-excluded races for that series, rounded to the nearest tenth. (Example: 1-2-RC-4-5 shall be scored $(1+2)/2=1.5$ for the race when the boat performed RC duty. RC will not get "credit" towards points, unless at least one boat in their class completes the race.
- f) If the race is abandoned, no boat will receive a score for that race.

This change is to clarify the intent that: If a boat is serving as RC, and no one in their class finishes the race / is scored, but other members of other classes do finish the race / get scored... then the RC does not get scoring credit for that race.
