The **ILCA DINGHY/LASER FROSTBITE REGATTA** scheduled in Fishing Bay for Sunday was also canceled - high winds, flooding, and crowded anchorages (sheltering boats) were cited. These cancellations followed a particularly grim, frigid, and wet day on Saturday, building up to the gale conditions, that brought about the cancellation of the small boat **HYC FALL FLING REGATTA**. Bah! on the weather.

Four (4) skippers and crew did get in a special shorter version of the Willoughby Racers (BBSA) annual **HOT BUTTERED RUM RACE** on Saturday. Within the cozy confines of Willoughby Bay, aka Little Bay, one boat in the Silver fleet finished the 6.8 nm course, and the three boats in the Gold Fleet managed their 4.4 nm course.
