APRIL FOOL'S DAY REGATTA. Sometimes racers can be foolish, especially on April Fool's Day. However, with the April Gale arriving in Hampton Roads in the wee hours of Saturday, organizers of the April Fool's One Design Regatta were wise indeed. Word of the cancellation was out shortly after the Friday small craft warnings went up for the weekend. Gusts to 40 knots were expected, defying challenge on Saturday morning. (See Murphy's Law).

Sunday morning, a plethora of boats were greeted by race-perfect waters and enticing breezes (10-15, w/gusts to 20 knots) - chilly though. Racing was in the harbor and the race committee offered two races to the big boat fleet stalwarts, giving all the crews opportunities for two starts and two +/- 5 miles courses around fixed marks. The harbor scene was completed with three of the J24s that had planned to be racing on Saturday working out at Strawberry Banks and a flock of 7 Optis and their coaches skirting the course area. Tune-Up Races Race Committee: Greg Cutter (PRO) and Carie Cutter (on HYC's *Kerry Sue*).

MID-WEEK RACING Opens this week: Each of these Series run throughout the summer season.

• HYC Wednesday Nights (April 5=first race) – FREE open to all, must complete entry form – Racing is in Hampton Roads harbor. Starts will be provided for three different fleets - one Non-Spinnaker and two Spinnaker fleets. The Spinnaker fleets will be split at PHRF rating 100. The Order of Starts will be as follows: All Non-Spin, Spin 2 (Over 100), Spin 1 (Under 100). In April, May, and September, the Warning Signal is scheduled for 1800. In June, July, and August, Warning is scheduled for 1830. RRS 26 Starting System is used and racers should plan to maintain the much-enjoyed informality of the series. The race format, similar to previous years, is described in a separate Race Brochure, which is available at the Dockside Lounge. The brochure will give all pertinent information regarding starting times, courses to be sailed, marks descriptions, and procedures to be followed. Each Skipper is requested to stop by the HYC to fill out the required Entry Form/Waiver which is also available at the Lounge. Skippers are urged to please comply with this requirement before doing their first Wednesday Night Race. There is no entry fee for the series. All boats meeting required standards, regardless of yacht club affiliation, are welcome to participate.
