Mike Austin wins 2012 York River Cup in MOVIN' ON. On his way to winning the Cup, Mike won both races in the PHRF spinnaker fleet sailed on Saturday at the mouth of the York River. In the PHRF Non-Spin fleet, **Steve Bowen**, *DREAM ON*, also won both races. The racing and the post-race party were hosted by York River Yacht Club.

There are a lot of folks in the sport of racing who deserve special appreciation. One such group includes **owners who loan their boats** for special one-design regattas. Here's a partial account of what one southern Bay owner's new boat went through a week ago at a major regatta. *"Fourteen (14) of about 26 races [were] in blustery, gusty conditions. Surely, loaners may have to buy new set [of sails] to be competitive in one design events with "newer" boats. Many of the boats furled their jibs with powerful multiple purchase fine tune on jib halyard and creased the jibs. One carbon fiber sprit broke during a massive broach by Texas Corinthian (rudder and stern out of the water, chute and sprit diving to China). After recovery and last finish, RC stopped racing for about 20 minutes while the NYYC Bosun raced in to the Alofsin piers, took the sprit off the "spare boat", raced back and changed out the sprit. Three other J70s broached without apparent damage. Only a few sail tears over the week, all in the J70s. The spreaders in the rig on my boat touched tips with another J70 on a start, without hanging, but no damage is visible from the ground."* (from Noel Clinard, who loaned his boat)
