**Tune-Up complete – Spring Series on the horizon.** More than a dozen southern Bay racers took advantage of the beautiful conditions Sunday at the CCV Tune-Up Races. Racing in Hampton Roads Harbor, the teams left rust from boats, skippers and crew in the wind as they prepared for the coming season. Tom Connor was the Principal Race Officer. In addition to the Tune-Up Races, there was racing scheduled on Wednesday at Little Creek (BBSA) and Hampton (HYC), on Thursday at Willoughby (BBSA), on Friday at the barnacle Series (PBC), and on Saturday at the Trapeze Regatta (HYC). The Lasers were out too at the ODU sailing center on Sunday. In addition to the CCV Spring Series opening day and Fishing Bay YC's opening Spring Series Sunday, *the coming week* will include the first Wednesday night at York River Yacht Club.

**CCV Spring Series opens THIS COMING SUNDAY, April 13.** This is the first day (Race Day 1, Races #1 and #2) of the series, featuring two drop mark races in Hampton Roads Harbor. The first warning is set for 1030. The Series is open to all PHRF Classes as well as a Cruising Fleet. *Racing Members* of CCV are automatically entered in the Series. All others must submit an entry form no later than Saturday, April 12. Racers may enter one race day at a time or the entire Series (per Race Day - \$30 / \$35 for non-USSA members). **Trapeze Regatta.** An enthusiastic bunch of International 505, J24 skippers and crew, and one Lightning, hit the water Saturday in the Trapeze Regatta hosted by Hampton Yacht Club. The wait for decent weather has been long and many others had to spend the weekend catching up on readiness tasks, but not this group. Both fleets got in 6 races in the vicinity of Hampton Flats. **Tyler Moore** easily won the 6 boat 505 fleet with 5 firsts and a second. **Henry Amthor** was 2<sup>nd</sup>, one point ahead of **Nelson** in the final standings. Mean while among the three boats racing Portsmouth Handicap, **Joe Buczkowski, Irie** (Lightning), proved to be a force with which to be reckoned. Joe won all but one of the six races. **Neil Ford and Lis Biondi's** J24, *Rocket J*, was 2<sup>nd</sup> overall and **Alan Bomar's** J24, *Roundabout*, was 3<sup>rd</sup>. Brian Deibler was the Principal Race Officer.

**65<sup>th</sup> DOWN THE BAY RACE - May 23-24, 2014, Friday and Saturday of Memorial Day weekend.** This really is the longest race on the Bay. Start is in Annapolis and finish is in Hampton, a 120 nautical mile course. Entries are due by May 5 (late entries, with a late fee, will be accepted until May 21). PHRF Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker fleets are building as is a multi-hull class; to date a total of 17 entries are ready to "do the dash" down the Bay for the Virginia Cruising Cup. The Skippers Meeting and Welcome Party are on Thursday, May 22, 1800-2100, at Severn Sailing Association in Eastport. The post-race party in Hampton will start at 1900 on Saturday, May 24, at Hampton YC. **Special for Women.** Hampton Yacht Club has started a **Friday evening women's race program**, using the club's Sonars and racing in the vicinity of Hampton Flats. The program is open to HYC women members or women participating in the Limited Members Adult Sailing Program. The schedule is set up so that racing will be [almost] every other Friday, beginning April 18 and running through October 17. The specific dates are: Apr 18, May 02 & 23, Jun 06 & 20, Jul 11 & 25, Aug 08 & 22, Sep 5 & 19, Oct 3 & 17. *The race entry fee is \$10 per race and may be paid at registration on race day* – it's a pay as you go program. On racing days, registration opens at 5pm, skipper and crew selection is at 6pm (no standing teams), warning signal at 6:15pm, and social and awards at 8pm.
