STINGRAY POINT REGATTA. Saturday and Sunday, SPR turned out to be a tale of two winds. On Saturday, racing started in 20++ knots of wind, dropped to a hospitable 15 knots for the second race, and was at a positively genteel 12 knots by race #3. Twenty-four (24) skippers and crew, the majority of whom started all 3 of the 5.6nm / 4.8nm drop mark races, experienced a "sporty" day on the race course. On Sunday, when the PHRF-A and B tackled 12.4nm, and PHRF C and NS each sailed 8.2nm for the single Distance Race, the winds were significantly calmer, i.e. a zephyr-like east breeze, 8-10 and fading fast. The PHRF-B fleet missed its time limit for the Distance Race, and the J70 one-design class did two 2nm shortened races instead of the longer race.. When all was said and done, a total of 27 boats sailed in the regatta.
