Spring Series

April 4, 11, 18, 25 May 2, 9, 16

Summer Series

May 23 June 6, 13, 20, 27 July 11, 18

Fall Series

July 25 August 1, 15, 22, 29 September 5, 12

Rules: Races will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

Entries: Open to all BBSA members at least 18 years of age. Boat must be monohull at least 20 feet long, self-

righting, with an enclosed cabin. Boats shall meet the safety equipment requirements of the US Sailing Near Shore category with the addition of 2.4.6, 2.4.7, 2.5.1, and 2.7.2). These requirements can be viewed

Registration: Registration is online at https://broadbaysailing.org/WRHome. No boat will be scored for a race unless it

has been registered and the skipper has paid the entry fee, signed the competitor's waiver, and signed up for a committee boat slot (unless all slots have been filled) prior to 1700 hours on the day of the race. this year (available at www.phrfchesbay.org). A courtesy rating will be temporarily assigned (if needed)

for the Spring Series until the skipper receives their Valid Rating.

Races: Held in Willoughby Bay (also known as Little Bay). The warning signal for the first class will be scheduled

for 1800 hours.

Skipper's Meeting: Skippers' Meeting will be held at Rebel Marina Breezeway club house on Thursday, March 28th @ 1800
