- Entries:** All boats that enter six races that are completed* in a class (five for the Cruising Class) are eligible for trophies. The races are:

- Instructions:** Each race will be conducted by the sponsoring yacht club per their sailing instructions for that race.
- Classes:** PHRF A, B, C, and N (as split for Region IV South), and Cruising. The Cruising Class is not available in the Down the Bay race.
- Scoring:** RRS Appendix A, except that A2.2 and A9 shall not apply. Each boat shall receive scores for individual races she has entered according to the results provided by the organizers of each completed race. Scores for fleets that are combined (ex. B/C) in a race will be separated and rescored per the PHRF Region IV South fleets. Scores for fleets that are split (ex. B1/B2) will be combined and rescored per the Region IV South fleets, as long as the race distance is the same; if they are not the same distance, then the reported scores will be used (there could be more than one 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc. in the same race). Races with both N (2HS) and N (1HS) fleets will use the reported scores (there could be more than one 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc. in the same race). Boats not entering a race will receive a score for that race equal to the total number of boats entered in that race, plus two. Down the Bay will not be considered a “race” for the Cruising Class.
- The number of throw-outs will be determined by the number of races completed in each class: three throw-outs if at least 10 races are completed, two throw-outs if 8-9 races are completed, one throw-out if 7 races are completed, and no throw-outs if fewer than 7 races are completed. A race is “completed*” if at least one boat in the class is scored as a finisher. Six completed races shall constitute a series; five for Cruising.
- Awards:** 1st for 2 qualifiers, 2nd for 3 qualifiers, 3rd for 4 or more qualifiers. Trophies will be presented at the year-end CCV Awards Party.
